Graduation Ceremony

Needed: 12-14 PTA Parent Guardian Volunteers

- 8 volunteers to help take tickets at the entrances to Taft Field.
 - 4 at the north gate and 4 at the southwest gate. More are welcome. They will work with Student Volunteers before the ceremony to keep the stands clear and then to take tickets/distribute programs as spectators enter.
- No entry until 5:00 pm. After the procession and National Anthem, guests without tickets may be allowed to enter and fill empty seats.
- 2 volunteers needed to stand by the gate in the black wire fence at the concession-stand to monitor access to the track and direct traffic to the rest rooms.
